Spectrum is excited to be offering FTTH (Fiber To The Home) service in your subdivision. Below are a few of the requirements to be able to install our advanced services to your home with minimum impact.

If your home is under construction we strongly recommend having a conduit placed from the exterior of your home next to power (where coax and cat5 are generally placed) to the distribution point inside your home where all of the coax and cat5 cabling is terminated. This is often called the smart panel.

With FTTH service that Spectrum will be offering in your subdivision it will require a fiber line placed from the exterior of your home to the interior. Fiber lines are generally not installed by builders into the home. Having a conduit in place will help avoid aesthetic issues with post-wiring of the home.

If your home is already completed and there is no conduit to the interior of the home to the smart panel we will work with you to provide the best possible solution to access the smart panel with minimal visual impact to the exterior of your home. In these situations Spectrum will possibly need access to the crawlspace or attic to complete the installation.
